Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School community recognises that uniform guidelines enables students, parents and staff to have clear directions on designated uniforms and personal standards. The school uniform gives the school an identity within the Springsure community and also fosters unity and equality amongst the students and enables them to displays loyalty and respect for their school.


Enrolment in Our Lady of the Sacred Heart School requires students to wear the prescribed school uniform when in attendance at school or representing the school in the wider community. The uniform is to be worn in accordance with the school values and Uniform Guidelines as outlined below.

Condition of Uniform	<p>The Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School uniform must be neat, clean and in good repair.</p> <p>Students are to wear the school uniform which is purchased from the school only.</p>	
Formal Uniform: Worn on Fridays		
	Boys Formal Uniform	<p>Hat: Navy with school logo</p> <p>Shirt: Blue school shirt with logo</p> <p>Pants: Navy blue with school logo</p> <p>Socks: White – above ankle bone</p> <p>Shoes: Entirely black shoes</p>
	Girls Formal Uniform	<p>Hat: Navy with school logo</p> <p>Shirt: Striped Blouse with logo</p> <p>Skort: School stocked navy skort</p> <p>Socks: White – above ankle bone</p> <p>Shoes: Entirely black shoes</p>

Sports Uniform: Worn Monday – Thursday

	<p align="center">Sports Uniform</p>	<p>Hat: As above Shorts: School sports shorts OR school stocked navy skort Shirts: Blue, navy & gold polo neck T-shirt Socks: White socks – above ankle bone Shoes: Entirely black shoes</p>

House Shirts: Worn to Designated Sports Carnivals

	<p align="center">Team Colours/Shirts</p>	<p>Students are invited to wear their team colours; Nogoia – red or Zamia – green to designated sporting carnivals (eg. Swimming, Athletics, Cross Country etc). The school have green and red shirts available for pre-order.</p> <p>Students are required to wear their navy sports shorts with their team colours.</p>

<p align="center">Winter Uniform</p>	<p>In cold weather, the below items can be added to the formal and sports school uniform:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current school jackets • Plain navy jumpers • Plain navy tights (girls to wear underneath uniform) • Plain navy track pants

<p align="center">Hairstyle</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair is to be neatly groomed • The student’s own natural colour • If shoulder length or longer, tied back away from the face with a navy/ yellow or white hair accessory. • There are to be no rats tails, no mohawks, no mullets or similar hairstyles. • There are to be no extremes in style or cut. • Hair bands or ribbons should be plain and be representative of the school colours. <p>If doubt exists with a style of hair, parents should check with the Principal before having a style change.</p>

<p align="center">Jewellery</p>	<p>Students are permitted to wear:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A wrist watch • A Christian symbol such as a crucifix or medal worn on a plain chain

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One pair of small, plain studs - one in each lobe • Appropriate school badges
Fingernails	Nail polish is not permitted. Fingernails should be trimmed to fingertip length.
Make-Up	Make-up is not permitted to be worn.
Free Dress Days	<p>The Principal or delegate will clearly stipulate what type of 'free dress day' it will be on the information.</p> <p>Free Dress Days On Free Dress Days, students must wear appropriate sunsafe clothing. Shirts with sleeves covering their shoulders and upper arms, shorts of an appropriate length and closed in shoes.</p> <p>Add Colour to your Uniform On days where students are invited to add colour to their uniform, they are to wear the uniform they would normally wear on the day and are able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add coloured socks or • Add a coloured hairtie or ribbon • Add a coloured tie <p>Crazy Hair Day Crazy Hair Day permits to changing only the student's hair. They are able to use any medium to make their hair 'crazy'. This can include coloured headbands, hairties, hairclips or hairspray. Students need to be able to wear a hat, if they would like to play in the sun.</p>
Swimming Lessons/Swimming Carnivals	<p>Students are required to wear:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rash shirt or swimming togs with sleeves • Swimmers • Thongs to travel to and from the pool
Identification	All clothing items should be clearly marked with the student's name.
Acceptable	The Principal (or delegate) retains the right to decide what is acceptable.
